

### Setup by APP

1. Download the Harman Kardon Remote app to help you easily join your Wi-Fi network.



2. Find "+" in the dashboard, then press it for a step by step guide.



### For iOS user

#### Wi-Fi Sharing with Cable


1. Connect your iPhone, iPad or iPod touch to the speaker using the USB to 30-pin or USB to Lightning cable provided with your iPhone, iPad or iPod touch.




2. Ensure your iPhone, iPad or iPod touch is connected to your Wi-Fi network.



3. Press the Wi-Fi button on the Harman Kardon Aura for less than a second. A pop-up window will be displayed on your iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch with a message Share Wi-Fi Settings?



4. Press Allow.



5. The iPhone, iPad or iPod Touch will then share Wi-Fi settings with the Harman Kardon Aura and it will be connected to your Wi-Fi network. This takes at least 40 seconds.

Once the HK Aura is connected to the network, the Wi-Fi LED will light constant white and a sound prompt will be heard.

### Android or Mac/PC setup


1. Put the Harman Kardon Aura into Ad-hoc mode by touching the Wi-Fi button for more than 5 seconds (ensure there are no USB devices plugged into the USB port). The Wi-Fi LED will begin to flash.




2. Go to the Wi-Fi Settings page on your Mac, PC or Phone and connect to the network with the name HK\_Aura\*\*\*\*. This may take around 40 seconds depending on your device.



3. Open the web browser on your computer or phone/tablet, and in the address bar, type "192.168.1.1" and press enter. You should see the HK Aura setup page.



4. Choose the Wi-Fi network you want to join, enter the password and click "Save".



5. The Harman Kardon Aura will then attempt to connect to your Wi-Fi network. This may take up to one minute depending on your Wi-Fi router. If the connection is successful, the Wi-Fi LED will turn solid white and the connection successful tone can be heard. If the connection is unsuccessful or your password incorrect, the Wi-Fi LED will flash quickly. To try again, start from step 1.

**NOTE:** To restore the factory default settings, long press Source and Power button in Operational mode.
